This Website uses a technology called "cookies" to collect information about its use.

The cookies on this Website are used in order to create profiles based on browsing habits, to distinguish you from other Users and to identify problems. Also, as long as you give us your consent, we may use cookies that allow us to know your preferences and personalize the Website.

1. DEFINITION OF COOKIES

Cookies are computer files that are downloaded to your electronic device (computer, tablet, smartphone, etc.), in order to store data that can be recovered by the entity responsible for its installation.

The information collected through cookies may include (i) the date and time of visit to the Website, (ii) the pages visited, (iii) the duration of the visit, and (iv) the sites visited just before and after.

2. TYPES OF COOKIES USED

This Website uses its own cookies and third-party cookies.

Own cookies are sent to your device and managed exclusively by Cleverea to improve the quality of the service we provide and your experience as a User. These cookies are persistent, that is, they will remain installed for a certain time in your browser, in order to recognize you as a visitor and adapt the content that we can offer you to your preferences.

This Website also uses or will use the following types of cookies, which will be processed either by us directly or by third party collaborators:

- **Technical cookies:** They allow the User to browse and use the different options or services offered (e.g. control traffic and data communication, identify the session, access restricted-access elements, submit requests, store content, etc).
- **Personalization cookies:** They allow the User to access the Website with some predefined general characteristics (e.g., language, browser type, regional configuration, etc.).
- **Analysis cookies:** They allow the number of Users to be quantified and statistical measurements and analyzes of the use and activity made by the Users to be carried out, as well as the elaboration of their browsing profiles in order to make improvements to the Website. Specifically, we use the Google Analytics audience measurement system, a Google web analysis tool that allows us to know how the User interacts on our Website.
